Margaret A. "Peggy" (Potvin) Boardman, 70, of Somerset, passed away on Monday, February 5, 2018. She was the long time companion of ten years to David Marotte of Somerset.

Margaret was born in Fall River, the daughter of Aline (Dagesse-Lecomte) Potvin of Somerset and the late Edward R. Potvin. She was a graduate of Mount St. Mary's Academy, in Fall River. Peggy also attended and graduated from St. Anne's School of Nursing as a registered nurse. Mrs. Boardman worked at St. Anne's Hospital in Fall River, St. Luke's Hospital, in New Bedford, and Sturdy Memorial Hospital, in Attleboro, retiring in the early 1980's.

Margaret was Crowned Miss Fall River in 1965 and was known for her beautiful singing voice, quick wit, and the love she showed her precious grandchildren. Peggy was also an avid photographer.
